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Continuing Student Application Instructions

2017–2018 School Year

(application deadline - June 30, 2018)

- I. APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS Each applicant:
 - A. Must have received an award for the previous school year. Must be an African American male or female student who is a U.S. citizen and who is currently enrolled and who has completed the 10th or 11th grade at a public senior high school in one of the following school districts in Tacoma/Pierce County: Bethel, Clover Park, Franklin Pierce, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Tacoma, or University Place.
 - B. Must have maintained or exceeded the cumulative grade point average achieved during the previous academic school year (2016–2017).
 - C. Must provide evidence of his/her ability to master mathematics, science and English at a level equal to or exceeding his/her previous academic school year (2016–2017) grade point average.
- II. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS Each applicant must submit to the Awards Committee:
 - A. A certified copy of his/her transcripts reflecting **final grades** of the 2017–2018 academic year.
 - B. An updated copy of the PERSONAL / SCHOOL INFORMATION FORM containing statements about his/her involvement in school activities; participation in community activities and organizations; receipt of any awards, certificates or special recognition; future educational/career goals; and church affiliation, if applicable.
 - C. THREE (3) letters of recommendation: (a) ONE from applicant's parent/ guardian; (b) ONE from a school staff person, and (c) ONE from a community representative (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.).
 - D. Must write a well-structured, well-researched, well-written essay of at least 250 words on the subject: "Who do you feel is responsible for your safety in school & what steps should be taken to ensure that safety? How do, or should, you ensure your voice is heard on this and other civic issues?"
 - E. *PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT THIS IS A NEW QUESTION!* The Elizabeth Wesley committee would like to learn more about your plans after high school in regards to your career aspirations. Please answer this question in as much detail as needed to explain what your plans are. **"What postsecondary education and/or training will you need to meet your** career interest & how do you plan to acquire the education, training & experience needed to obtain your career goal?"

III. EVALUATION CRITERIA – Each applicant will be evaluated on:

- A. The quality of his/her school transcript and the extent to which it reflects an improvement in the previous year's grade point average in Mathematics, Science and English courses.
- B. The degree to which he/she is involved in school activities.
- C. The scope of his/her involvement in community activities (for example: any volunteer work at church and/or community based organization).
- D. The content of his/her letters of recommendation.
- E. The content of his/her essay.

IV. INCENTIVE AWARDS

- A. The ELIZABETH WESLEY YOUTH INCENTIVE AWARDS COMMITTEE will give each award winner THREE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$350.00) DOLLARS.
- B. The Awards Committee will present the award directly to the student for his/her use.
- C. Award winners must participate in recipient orientation (August 15, 2018).
- D. Award winners must attend the awards ceremony (September 15, 2018).
- E. All awards must be claimed no later than October 26, 2018 or they will be forfeited.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must submit all required documents listed in A, B and C of Section II (Applicant Requirements) above to the **Awards Committee** no later than **Saturday, June 30, 2018.** Applications received or postmarked after the closing date will be returned.

Completion of the application process does not guarantee an award. Awards will be limited by the financial resources of the program.
