New Student Application Instructions

2018–2019 School Year

(application deadline – June 28, 2019)

I. APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS – Each applicant:

- A. **Must be an African American male or female student** who is a U.S. citizen and is currently enrolled in the **9th, 10th, or 11th** grade at a junior or senior public high school in one of the following school districts in Tacoma/Pierce County: **Bethel, Clover Park, Franklin Pierce, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Tacoma, or University Place.**
- B. Must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better at the end of the 2018–2019 academic school year.

II. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS – Each applicant must submit to the Awards Committee:

- A. A certified copy of his/her transcripts reflecting **final grades** of the 2018–2019 academic year.
- B. A completed PERSONAL / SCHOOL INFORMATION FORM containing statements about his/her involvement in school activities; participation in community activities and organizations; receipt of any awards, certificates or special recognition; future educational/career goals; and church affiliation, if applicable.
- C. THREE (3) letters of recommendation: (a) ONE from applicant's parent/guardian; (b) ONE from a school staff person, and (c) ONE from a community representative (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.).
- D. Must write a well-structured, well-researched, well-written essay of at least 250 words on the subject: **“The voting system used today to elect the President of the United States is the electoral college system. Some believe we should elect the President by virtue of the popular vote. What are the pros and cons of a popular voting system and which would you prefer (popular or electoral college) and why?”**
- E. **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT THIS IS A NEW QUESTION!** The Elizabeth Wesley committee would like to learn more about your plans after high school in regards to your career aspirations. Please answer this question in as much detail as needed to explain what your plans are. **“What post-secondary education and/or training will you need to meet your career interest & how do you plan to acquire the education, training & experience needed to obtain your career goal?”**

III. EVALUATION CRITERIA – **Each applicant will be evaluated on:**

- A. The quality of his/her school transcripts and grade point average in the specific areas of Mathematics, Science and English.
- B. The degree to which he/she is involved in school activities.
- C. The scope of his/her involvement in community activities (for example: any volunteer work at church and/or community based organization).
- D. The content of his/her letters of recommendation.
- E. The content of his/her essay.

IV. INCENTIVE AWARDS

- A. The ELIZABETH WESLEY YOUTH INCENTIVE AWARDS COMMITTEE will give each award winner THREE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$350.00) DOLLARS.
- B. The Awards Committee will present the award directly to the student for his/her use.
- C. **Award winners must participate in recipient orientation** (August 21, 2019).
- D. **Award winners must attend the awards ceremony** (September 21, 2019).
- E. All awards must be claimed no later than October 25, 2019 or they will be forfeited.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must submit all required documents listed in Section II (Applicant Requirements) above to the **Awards Committee** no later than **Friday, June 28, 2019**. Applications received or postmarked after the closing date will be returned.

Completion of the application process does not guarantee an award. Awards will be limited by the financial resources of the program.
