# Student Application 2019–2020 School Year

Application deadline - June 30, 2020

- I. APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS Each applicant:
  - A. Must be an African American male or female student who is a U.S. citizen and is currently enrolled in the 9th, 10th, or 11th grade at a junior or senior public high school in one of the following school districts in Tacoma/Pierce County: Bethel, Clover Park, Franklin Pierce, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Tacoma, or University Place.
  - B. Must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better at the end of the **2019–2020** academic school year.

### II. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS – Each applicant must submit to the Awards Committee:

- A. A certified copy of his/her transcripts reflecting **final grades** of the **2019–2020** academic year.
- B. A completed PERSONAL / SCHOOL INFORMATION FORM containing statements about his/her involvement in school activities; participation in community activities and organizations; receipt of any awards, certificates or special recognition; future educational/career goals; and church affiliation, if applicable.
- C. THREE (3) letters of recommendation: (a) ONE from applicant's parent/guardian; (b) ONE from a school staff person, and (c) ONE from a community representative (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.).
- D. A well-structured, well-researched, essay of at least 250 words on the subject: The Elizabeth Wesley Youth Merit Incentive Award Program was established in 1995 and named for a community matriarch for whom education for youth was a high priority. In Mrs. Wesley's name, the greater Tacoma-Pierce County community was asked to provide incentive for youth to stay in school and achieve academic excellence while also demonstrating a commitment to volunteerism and working to better their community. Given your knowledge about Mrs. Wesley and the 25 years of community support for African American students through this program, how does it provide incentive and encouragement for you to do your best to achieve academic excellence? Describe the importance of community organizations like E Wesley & how do you plan to "pay it forward" to help E Wesley continue for another 25 years? #### III. EVALUATION CRITERIA – Each applicant will be evaluated on:

- A. The quality of his/her school transcripts and grade point average in the specific areas of Mathematics, Science and English.
- B. The degree to which he/she is involved in school activities.
- C. The scope of his/her involvement in community activities (for example: any volunteer work at church and/or community based organization).
- D. The content of his/her letters of recommendation.
- E. The content of his/her essay.

#### IV. INCENTIVE AWARDS

- A. The ELIZABETH WESLEY YOUTH INCENTIVE AWARDS COMMITTEE will give each award winner THREE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$350.00) DOLLARS.
- B. The Awards Committee will present the award directly to the student for his/her use.
- C. Award winners must participate in recipient orientation August 19, 2020.
- D. Award winners must attend the awards ceremony September 19, 2020.
- E. All awards must be claimed no later than **October 30**, **2020** or they will be forfeited.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must submit all required documents listed in Section II (Applicant Requirements) above to the **Awards Committee** no later than **June 30**, **2020**. Applications received or postmarked after the closing date will be returned.

Completion of the application process does not guarantee an award. Awards will be limited by the financial resources of the program.
