# Student Application 2022–2023 School Year

Application deadline - June 30, 2023

If you are submitting a paper application please do not submit a duplicate on-line application.

Only one application will be considered i.e., an on-line or a completed paper application.

- I. APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS Each applicant:
  - A. Must be an African American student who is a U.S. citizen and is currently enrolled in the 9th, 10th, or 11th grade at a junior or senior public high school in one of the following school districts in Tacoma/Pierce County: Bethel, Clover Park, Franklin Pierce, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Tacoma, or University Place.
  - B. Must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better at the end of the **2022–2023** academic school year.
- II. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS Each applicant must submit to the Committee:
  - A. A certified copy of student transcript reflecting **final grades** of the **2022–2023** academic year. (deadline for transcript July 14, 2023)
  - B. A completed PERSONAL / SCHOOL INFORMATION FORM containing statements about applicants involvement in school activities; participation in community activities and organizations; receipt of any awards, certificates or special recognition; future educational/career goals; and church affiliation, if applicable.
  - C. THREE (3) letters of recommendation: (a) ONE from applicant's parent/guardian; (b) ONE from a school staff person, and (c) ONE from a community representative (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.).
  - D. A well-structured, well-researched, essay of at least 250 words on the subject: What are the two most significant challenges facing your generation and what plans have you formulated to address them?
  - E. The Elizabeth Wesley committee would like to learn more about your plans after high school in regards to your career aspirations. Please answer this question in as much detail as needed to explain what your plans are. What post-secondary education and/or training will you need to meet your career interest & how do you plan to acquire the education, training & experience needed to obtain your career goal?

#### III. EVALUATION CRITERIA – Each applicant will be evaluated on:

- A. The quality of school transcripts and grade point average in the specific areas of Mathematics, Science and English.
- B. The degree to which applicant is involved in school activities.
- C. The scope of applicants involvement in community activities (for example: any volunteer work at church and/or community based organization).
- D. The content of applicants letters of recommendation.
- E. The content and quality of applicants essay.

#### IV. INCENTIVE AWARDS

- A. The ELIZABETH WESLEY YOUTH MERIT INCENTIVE AWARDS PROGRAM will give each award winner THREE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$350.00) DOLLARS.
- B. The Committee will present the award directly to the students.
- C. Award winners must participate in recipient orientation August 16, 2023. (Requirements may change due to public safety regulations)
- D. Award winners must attend the awards ceremony September 16, 2023. (Requirements may change due to public safety regulations)
- E. All awards must be claimed no later than **October 31**, **2023** or they will be forfeited.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must submit all required documents listed in Section II (Applicant Requirements) above to the **Committee** no later than **June 30**, **2023**. Mailed applications received or postmarked after the closing date will be returned. Transcript deadline is **July 14**, **2023**.

Completion of the application process does not guarantee an award. Awards will be limited by the financial resources of the program.
